What is ABATE of Maryland, Inc.?

ABATE of Maryland, Inc. is the only organization in Maryland exclusively engaged in representing the rights of Maryland motorcyclists, and we have been doing so since 1974. Our members have joined together to advocate training as the foremost means of reducing accidents and injury, to put an end to discriminatory legislation, to communicate clearly, to explore ways to improve the overall motorcycling experience in Maryland, and to provide for and assure the continuing freedom and affordability of motorcycling.

What Does ABATE stand for?

A Brotherhood Against Totalitarian Enactments

What Does ABATE Do?

ABATE of Maryland, Inc. formulates plans and strategies for developing and introducing motorcycle legislation which strengthens our rights as riders. We lobby in Annapolis every Monday nights when the House and Senate are in session, and also attend special meetings and special sessions when necessary.

Although we are sometimes referred to as "those anti-helmet guys," we are absolutely not "anti-helmet". We feel very strongly that helmet use alone is insufficient to ensure a motorcyclist's safety. The American Motorcyclist Association and the Motorcycle Riders Foundation both agree, along with state motorcycle rights organizations across the country, that there is a broad range of other measures that can be implemented to improve the skill of motorcycle operators, as well as reduce the frequency of situations where other vehicle operators are the cause of crashes that involve motorcycles. Our position at ABATE is that motorcyclists' that are at least 21 years of age, have been licensed for at least 2 years, have completed a motorcycle safety course, or are passengers on a motorcycle operated by a driver who has been licensed for at least 2 years, or has completed a motorcycle safety course, should be given the FREEDOM of CHOICE, whether or not to wear a helmet. We do not tell anyone that they should not wear a helmet, our goal is that motorcyclists be given the option to decide for themselves.

Legislative Tidbits

HANDLEBAR HEIGHT: SB 0668 (2017) ABATE worked with the bill sponsors and settled on raising the handlebar height from 15" to 20" above the motorcycle seat.

MODIFIED EXHAUST SYSTEM-PENALTIES (HB-1333-2022): This bill would have banned modification of an exhaust system. ABATE testified against this and helped to defeat this bill

VEHICLE EMISSIONS PROGRAM (HB 46 / SB 104-2022):
ABATE lobbied against this bill as it would have required that all vehicles in the state pay an emissions fee, regardless of location and the fees would go towards funding the Maryland Strategic Energy Investment Fund to incentivize and purchase electric vehicles and expand electric vehicle infrastructure.



National Coalition of Motorcyclists

What is NCOM?

The National Coalition of Motorcyclists (NCOM) was born on January 27th, 1986, when motorcycle groups and leaders from around the nation met in Las Vegas, spurred by the need for a powerful, unified voice to stand up for the rights of bikers everywhere. Since that time, NCOM has continued to provide riders and motorcycle organizations with legal guidance, legislative backing, public awareness programs, and anti-discrimination services, among other resources.

NCOM is more than just a single organization; it is comprised of numerous motorcycle rights groups, clubs, and associations, all working together for the greater good of the biker community. Today, the coalition has expanded to include hundreds of thousands of riders and more than 2,000 member organizations from all over the United States.

At its core, NCOM is an association built and run by bikers for bikers. Its National Council, designed to facilitate effective communications nationwide, is comprised of one member from each participating organization. Motorcycle rights leaders representing 11 regions make up its Board of Advisors. The group also contains a Legislative Task Force that includes state legislators, advocates, and a United States Senator.

Unlike with other organizations, groups can join NCOM at no cost, gaining access to its tools and resources. NCOM does not impose membership fees or ask its members for funding. Instead, 100% of the organization's monetary backing is provided by the Aid to Injured Motorcycles (A.I.M.) program and its associated network of motorcycle injury lawyers. Each A.I.M. attorney gives a significant percentage of their legal fees from motorcycle accident cases to NCOM, ensuring that the coalition can continue in its work.

No matter what type of bike you ride or what patch you wear, all motorcycle groups are encouraged to join the National Coalition of Motorcyclists. 




