A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Motorcycles – Expiration of Learner’s Instructional Permit**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the expiration date for a certain learner’s instructional
4 permit for a motorcycle; and generally relating to a learner’s instructional
5 permit for a motorcycle.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 16–105.

15 (e) (1) This subsection only applies to an individual who holds a license
16 and who seeks a different class license to drive a motor vehicle that, under the
17 individual’s current license, the individual is not authorized to drive.

18 (2) The holder of a learner’s instructional permit may not take the
19 driver’s license examination sooner than 14 days after the permit is issued.

20 (3) The 14 days’ requirement may be waived if a subsequent learner’s
21 instructional permit is issued or applied for.

1 (4) A learner's instructional permit issued to an individual described
2 in paragraph (1) of this subsection expires:

3 **(I) FOR A LEARNER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT FOR A**
4 **MOTORCYCLE, 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE; OR**

5 **(II) FOR ANY OTHER LEARNER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT,**
6 180 days after **THE** date of issuance.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2012.
