

The reason for this action is the past Schaefer Administration changed the program, almost destroyed it, and then took our money, (legalized theft) and placed it in the General Trust Fund.

Much of the discussion during this meeting was focused on public awareness, which has been taken out of the program, and ways to put it back and promote motorcycling to the rest of Maryland. The MVA, (by the way, Administrator Anne Ferro was present) seemed very willing to help restore needed funding to the program, but of course, could not lend support to legislation to have our money returned. Delegate Poole informed them that legislation was a real possibility.

This issue has been a thorn in our side since our money was stolen. This is not the first time Delegate Poole has been involved in this issue. When the Schaefer Administration tried to kill the program, Delegate Poole was very instrumental in saving language and having it passed, to keep the safety program. Most recently, in November/December 1997, members from Washington County, Scott MacMichael, Lance Baker, and I met at Delegate Poole's office in Hagerstown, to discuss this very problem. Delegate Poole asked us then to hold off and let him see what he could do. I took this information back to the Board of Directors and we waited on Delegate Poole try it his way.


